**All qualifying models must be purchased at a participating retailer.*
- You have not submitted another Appalachian Power water dispenser rebate in 2019.
- Application must be submitted within 45 days from purchase date or by January 15, 2020, whichever comes first.

Get \$25 back from Appalachian Power on your purchase of a current ENERGY STAR certified water dispenser. This rebate is good for purchases made 1/1/19 through 12/31/19. Limit one rebate per residential electric customer account. Funding for this program is limited.

Please include a copy of your dated sales receipt and/or invoice from a participating retailer showing the manufacturer, model number and price of the ENERGY STAR certified water dispenser purchased and a copy of your recent electric bill. Incomplete information will delay or disqualify your rebate. All rebate requests must be postmarked no later than January 15, 2020. Please allow up to six weeks for rebate processing. Did You Know?

ENERGY STAR certified water coolers use about 30 percent less energy than conventional models. This difference could amount to an energy savings of nearly \$70 over the life of the unit.

Water coolers can offer hot, cold and room temperature water in a variety of new ways, including:

- **Bottom-Loading Bottled Water** units allow you to install the bottled water, spout up, at the bottom of unit. This eliminates the heavy lifting and occasional spills of conventional top-loading units.
- **Point of Use** units avoid bottled water by using a dedicated water line and filtering systems.
- **On Demand** units do not store conditioned water in internal tanks but provide hot and cool water upon request, thereby saving energy.
